The Dream Mile 5K

September 07th 2008

Between June and November 2008, thousands of people from in and around Chicago will each take a few purposeful steps in support of a mission that seeks to better the lives of underprivileged children.

From its inaugural year in 1999, The Dream Mile 5K has been our flagship event for fundraising as well as increasing awareness about the plight of less fortunate children. With every passing year, this event has grown from a small event attended by mostly Vibha supporters to a permanent fixture on the calendars of serious runners in these cities: Atlanta, Bay Area, Dallas, Twin Cities, Washington DC, Austin and Los Angeles.

Some examples of local charities supported in the past by Vibha are:

- 1. Part of proceeds from the Vibha Walk/Run 2006 in BayArea supported the Sacred Heart Community Service, San Jose and San Jose Neighbors That Care providing food and clothing to 200 at-risk children.
- 2. The Dream Mile 5K 2007 supported Future Families: an organization that helps children who have suffered from abuse, loss or trauma to grow into healthy adults.

Details - In Chicago this year, The Dream Mile 5K is scheduled for September 07th, 2008 at Busse Woods, Elk grove village, IL.

- 1. We are targeting total participation of over 100 runners this year with over 50 children who run for free.
- 2. Our media campaign reaches out to over 5000 high-income, urban professionals who live and work in and around Chicago.
- 3. These are people with high disposable incomes, high aspirations, an active outdoor lifestyle and who are conscious of the need to support those less lucky privileged than themselves.

The publicity campaign for the event is kicking in to high gear. Between now and the event day, our energetic volunteers will be working to publicize the event throughout Chicago. The publicity media for this event will include:

Vibha is a Sanskrit word that means *inner radiance* or *brightness* and it signifies our organization's vision of providing every underprivileged child with an opportunity for a brighter future.

We are a US based non-profit, non-religious, non-political volunteer organization that seeks to restore the promise of a future to underprivileged children by providing them access to education, healthcare, shelter and nourishment. In the US, Vibha volunteers raise awareness and resources to support child development initiatives in India and the US.

Since our inception in 1991, we have made a difference to the lives of thousands of underprivileged children and this has been possible only through the generosity and commitment of people like you.

To ensure that every underprivileged child attains his or her right to education, health and opportunity.

Educate, empower and enable every individual who wishes to make a positive difference in the life of an underprivileged child.

Since its inception, Vibha has raised nearly 6 million dollars with the help of patrons like you and has supported more than 110,000 children through 175 grassroots projects in India and the US.

Today, over 59 million Indian children in the school-going age are outside the school system. There are 18 million street children and over 15 million children living as bonded laborers.
